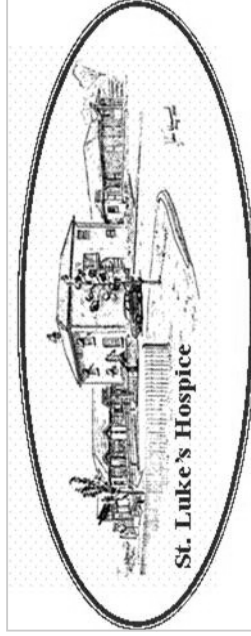


How will it help?

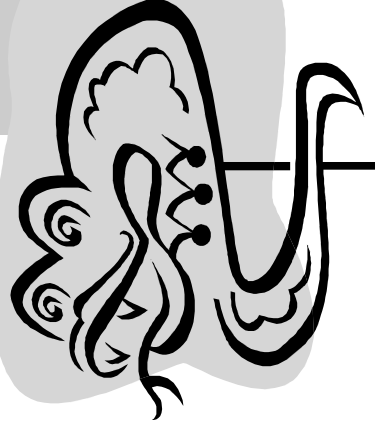
